NO INAUGURATION FUND

KATIE HOBBS

Created a shadowy Inauguration Fund that took more than **\$1M** more in **private donations** than the cost of the 2023 Inauguration, only revealing some donors after a public pressure campaign.

ANDY BIGGS

No Inauguration Fund. Arizonans are struggling and do not want to see politicians celebrating their own victory. Statewide officials will be sworn in at the Old Capitol building at 8:30am on Monday, January 4th and get to work; **we'll celebrate when we've accomplished something for the state.**



SIGNING VENDOR TRANSPARENCY LEGISLATION

KATIE HOBBS

Vetoed SB 1612, a bill with bipartisan support that would have **increased transparency** among companies that bid on state contracts or **request raises** to disclose contributions made by the company or its executives to political candidates or entities.

ANDY BIGGS

Work with Senator T.J. Shope to **sign a mirror bill of SB 1612 in his first month to improve transparency** and enable Arizonans to see which companies are **attempting to influence elected officials.**



STATE PROTOCOL FUND AND TRIP DISCLOSURE

KATIE HOBBS

Uses the State Protocol Fund as a slush fund for lobbyists to contribute without any timely disclosure of uses or contributors.

ANDY BIGGS

48-hour notice to the Legislature and public before State Protocol Funds are used with amount and reason for use, **72-hour disclosure of funds from contributors** upon receipt.



NO MORE FOREIGN DONATIONS INFLUENCING CAMPAIGNS

KATIE HOBBS

Uses a platform (ActBlue) found to have been likely **accepting foreign donations**, dismissive of financial interests from outside of Arizona influencing campaigns.

ANDY BIGGS

Work with Senator Mark Finchem to enact mirror referral resolution SCR 1005 to 2028 ballot box to **earn voter approval on the ban of foreign contributions to campaigns and initiatives.**



INITIATIVE SIGNATURE COLLECTOR TRANSPARENCY

KATIE HOBBS

Vetoed HB 4115, which would have brought **state requirements on paid and out of state signature collectors to local initiatives.**

ANDY BIGGS

Will sign mirror legislation of HB 4115 to **ensure Arizonans are not steamrolled at the local level** by powerful, out-of-state influencers.
